Prior to installing products, ensure that the firearm is unloaded, the magazine is removed, safety on and finger(s) off the trigger.

DO NOT install or use product if the installation of the product in any way affects the safe function of the firearm. If, while installing products, you have any trouble with the fit or functionality of the firearm, STOP IMMEDIATELY.

ALWAYS FOLLOW THE 4 RULES OF FIREARM SAFETY:

- 1. Handle all firearms as if they are loaded.
- 2. Never let the muzzle cover anything that you are not willing to destroy.
- Keep your finger off the trigger until your sights are on the target and you are ready to fire.
- 4. Be sure of your target and what is beyond.

Remember, the user is ALWAYS responsible for the safe use of a firearm! We recommends that every gun owner take a gun safety course from a certified NRA Instructor before handling or firing your firearm.

QUICK START GUIDE



1. INSTALL THE BATTERIES

Locate the battery compartment door under the laser unit, loosen battery cap with tool. Insert 2 button cell (LR44) Alkaline Batteries.

* DO preserve battery life by switching off a device and removing the batteries when it's not being used, and is not expected to be used for extended periods of time.

2. TURN ON

CAUTION: Use caution when activating the laser to avoid direct eye exposure, which can result in permanent eye damage. Follow all precautions as outlined by the firearms manufacturer. Keep this and all firearm related products locked and secured from children or other unauthorized users.





3. ADJUSTMENTS

Stinger laser sights are fully adjustable for windage and elevation if further adjustments are desired. A two-screw alignment system is used to adjust for windage and elevation. Use the supplied allen wrenches to make any adjustments.
